COLLAPSED BULK SEWER PIPELINES REPLACEMENT IN ORKNEY

The City of Matlosana has appointed experts in the bulk sewer pipeline field to replace the collapsed bulk clay sewer pipelines with the new 250 mm UPVC (solid plastic) pipeline in Milton to corner Charlotte Maxeke and Chauser Street in Orkney (Next to KFC).

The replacement is done at old clay sewer pipeline that has been causing challenges around the area to businesses as well as the residents and that it has reached its lifespan. Progress has been made since last week Tuesday, 21 June 2022 and is anticipated to be finalised in the second week of July 2022.

Management team of Sewer Services under the Directorate of Technical and Infrastructure in the City of Matlosana is pleased with the work so far and request the community of Orkney to be patient with the workers while they are still busy on site.

Residents of Orkney are also urged to be cautious when approaching the area and encourage the children to stay away from excavations as the old pipeline has been done in such a way that is far deeper than six meters hence the replacement also involves deep excavations to reach the link connection levels.
